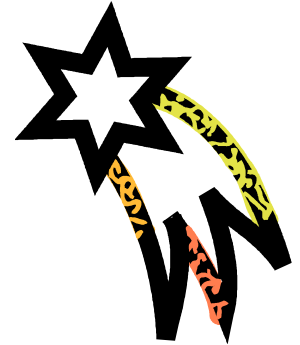
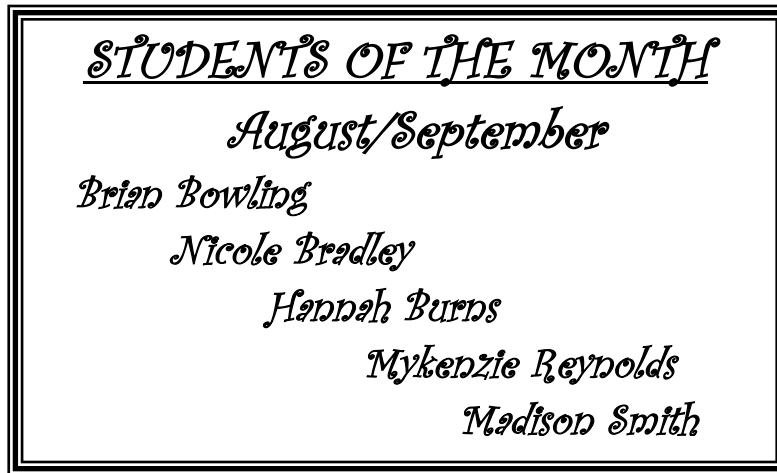

- **College Applications:** start narrowing down your college choices and begin to think about applying.
 - Take advantage of the 3 college visits.
 - Application Process:
 1. Decide on top 3-5 schools to Apply
 2. Apply via Online Application creating a username and password
 3. **NOTIFY THE GUIDANCE OFFICE** once you have completed and SUBMITTED your application! This is IMPORTANT. Your application will not be processed unless an OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT is sent directly from the High School.
 4. Send ACT scores directly to the college through www.actstudent.org
- DEADLINES: APPLICATION DEADLINES ARE SET AS SOON AS NOVEMBER 1ST TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SCHOLARSHIPS! START THE APPLICATION PROCESS NOW!!!
- Reminder to schedule a Pre-College Conference if you need assistance with the college application process!

 2. Schedule a College Visit with School of your Choice.
 3. Bring back documentation from college the next school day.
